

Activities to Actively Engage Readers

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Read a book and then use it as a springboard to.....

- Write a blog post up to 500 words in length reviewing an It List book.
- Create a digital promotional poster
- Create an original 2D Fan Art piece representing a scene or characters
- Compose a poem from the point of view of a character
- Write a letter to the author as a character from a book of their choice.
- Create a short video displaying the 5 books that have impacted their life the most.
- Write a short story prequel or sequel
- Make a video of a book talk expressing what you enjoyed/did not enjoy about the book
- Use a graphic design program to redesign the cover
- Create a Book Trailer video up to 3 minutes in length advertising an It List book.
- Create an infographic on a topic of their choice OR create an infographic about the time period during which the book is set. The infographic should include data graphs, pictures, and text. All information must be factual and research sources must be cited.
- Review an It book in a video blog
- Make a stop motion video that recreates one of your favorite moments from the story. Build the characters using Legos, clay or even paper art.
